Center Creek

This fast, narrow creek is probably more surrounded by urbanization than any other in the Ozarks. It is recommended primarily for medium-to-high water runs, but caution should be exercised near the numerous bridges and overhanging trees.

Difficulty: II and III. Numerous tricky runs with brush

or overhanging limbs.

Gradients: U.S. Alternate 71 to Oronogo — 6.1; to

Smithfield — 6.7.

0.0 South Garrison Avenue. Bridge. Minimal parking along the right-of-way.

9.3 Old mill dam site produces rocky rapids. May have to portage or walk through in moderate or low water.

10.1 Access from County Road 193. Do not try to access from Hwy. 171.

10.7 Old 66 Blvd. No public access.

11.7 Shelter cave in bluff on right. Private property. No trespassing.

12.0 Sharp, narrow drop over rock ledge.

13.6 Route D. Bridge. Fair access. Sharp drop just below bridge.

15.1 County Road 230 Bridge. No access.

16.4 Homestead Drive/County Road 240. Dirt pull-off southwest of bridge.

18.1 Stones Corner Access on right below Hwy. 43 Bridge.

19.9 Hwy. 171 Bridge and Kansas City South R.R. Bridge.

20.8 Carl Junction Center Creek Park. Open from sunrise to sunset. Access.

21.7 Thorn Station Trail Bridge. Old St. Louis and San Francisco R.R. Bridge.

22.1 Joplin Street Bridge.

23.5 Carl Junction Access on left just before Route JJ Bridge. Boat ramp closed at time of publication. Search "Carl Junction Access" at **mdc.mo.gov** for updates.
