

Platte River

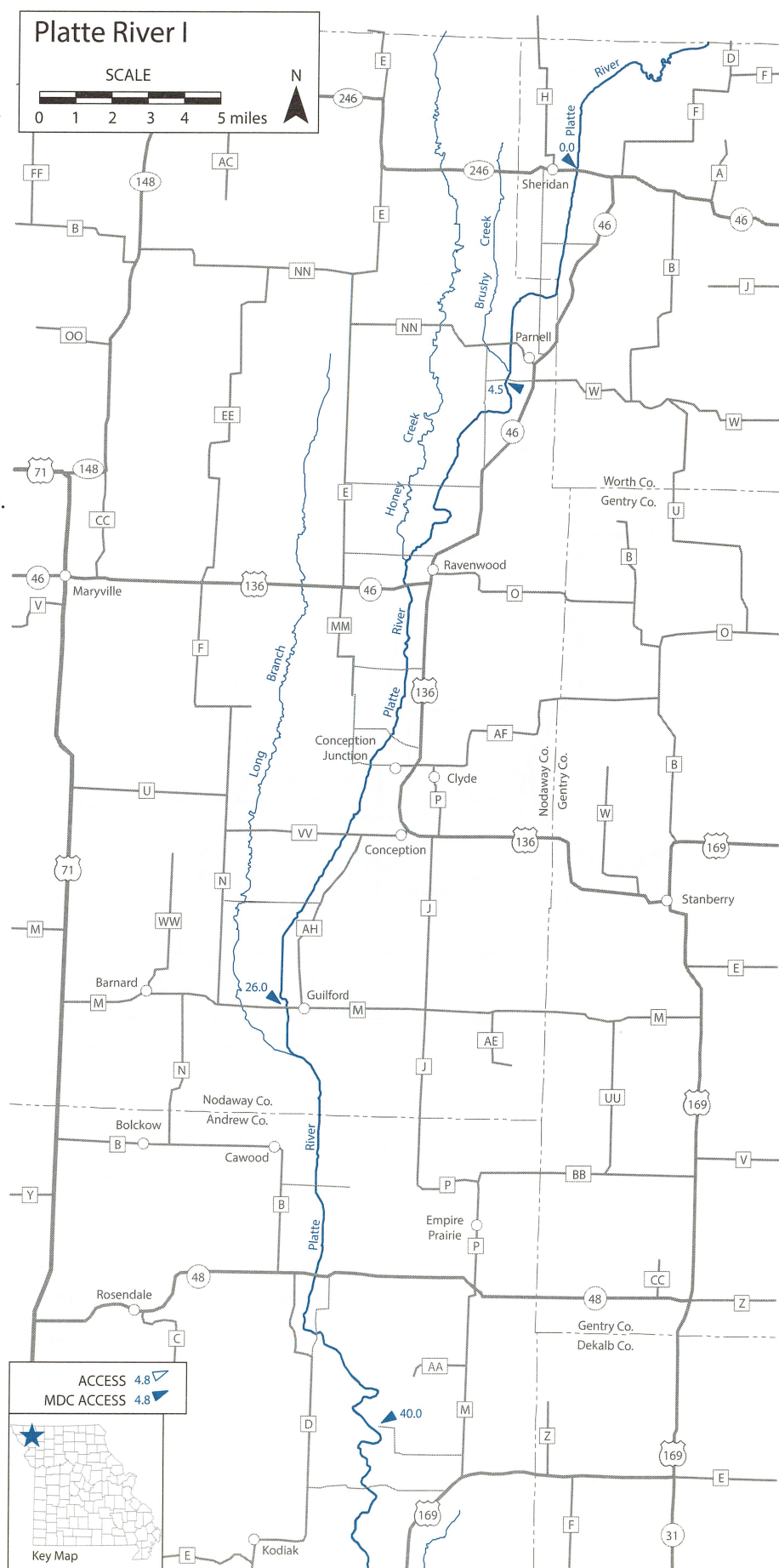
This river flows 138 miles from the Iowa state line through five Missouri counties to its confluence with the Missouri River north of Kansas City. Although part of it is channelized, it flows through six conservation areas.

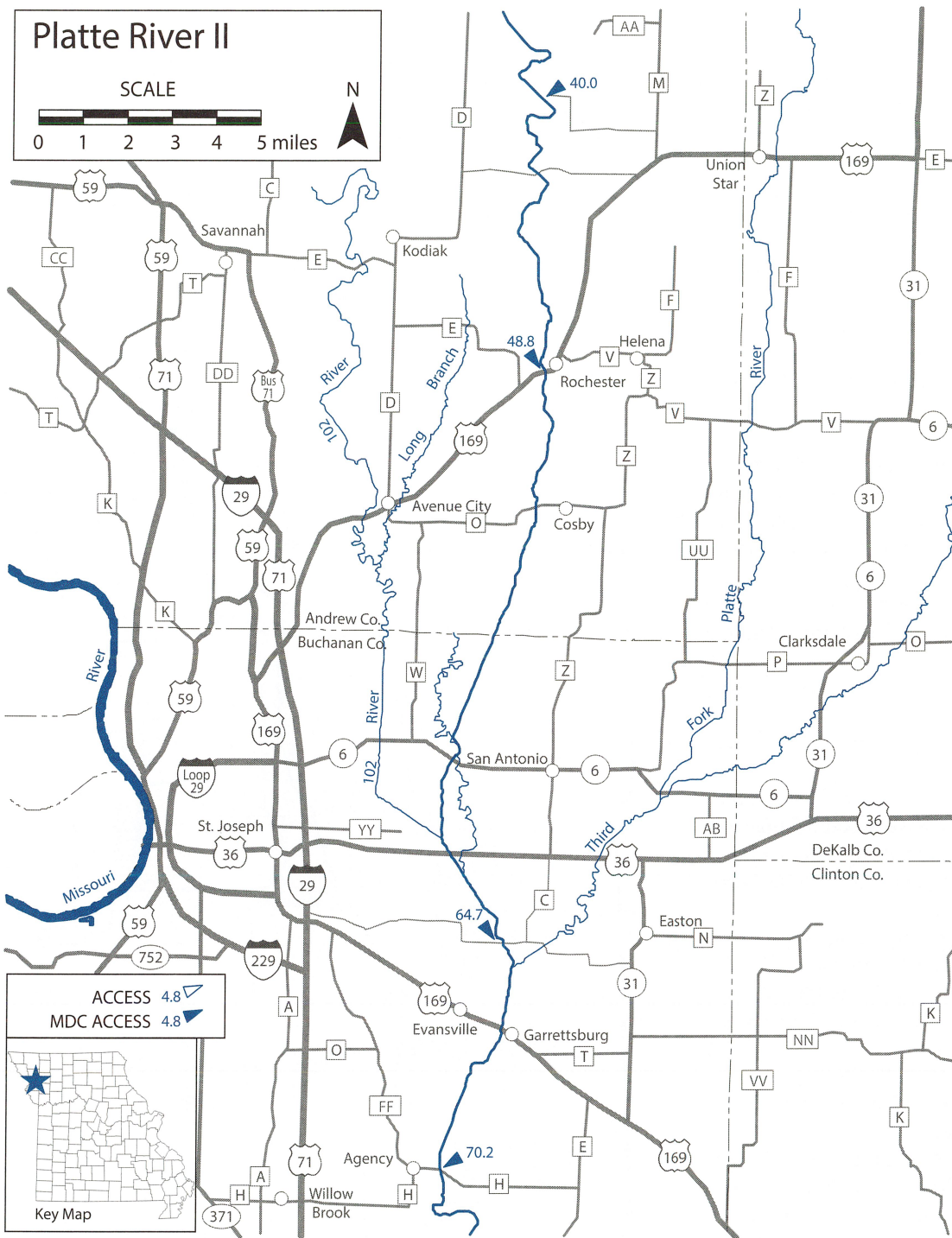
Difficulty: I and II.

- 11.2 Nodaway County 250th Street Bridge Ravenwood 0.5 mile east.
- 12.5 Hwy. 136 Bridge. No access.
- 15.0 Nodaway County 282nd Street Bridge.
- 17.4 Washed out bridge site. Conception Junction 1 mile north. No public access.
- 18.5 Nodaway County 310th Street Bridge.
- 20.5 Route VV Bridge.
- 23.0 Nodaway County 350th Street Bridge.
- 26.0 [Bristle Ridge Access](#) on Route M. Boat access difficult. No ramp and steep river bank.
- 31.2 Abandoned bridge site in Andrew County. Route B 1 mile west on Andrew County Road 88. No public access.
- 34.1 Hwy. 48 Bridge. No access.
- 36.6 Andrew County Road 198 Bridge. [Happy Holler Lake Conservation Area](#) 1 mile south.
- 40.0 [Elrod Mill Access](#) on Andrew County Road 216, off Andrew County Road 221. Canoe/kayak access moderate to difficult. No ramp and steep river bank. ▲

- 61.6 Andrew County Mitchell Road Southeast Bridge.

- 61.7 102 River on right.
- 62.0 Hwy. 36 Bridge. No access.
- 64.7 **Saxton Access** and bridge on Saxton/Easton Road in Buchanan County. Poor canoe/kayak access.
- 65.3 Third Fork Platte River on left.
- 66.8 Hwy. 169 Bridge. No access.
- 70.2 **Agency Access** on left, on Route H. Poor canoe/kayak access.
- 72.0 **Agency Conservation Area** on right. ▲
