Three tributaries form the Grand River. This map starts with the East Fork and continues down the Grand to the Missouri River. Portions have been channelized, but the river has plenty of fish and wildlife habitat and flows along several conservation areas.

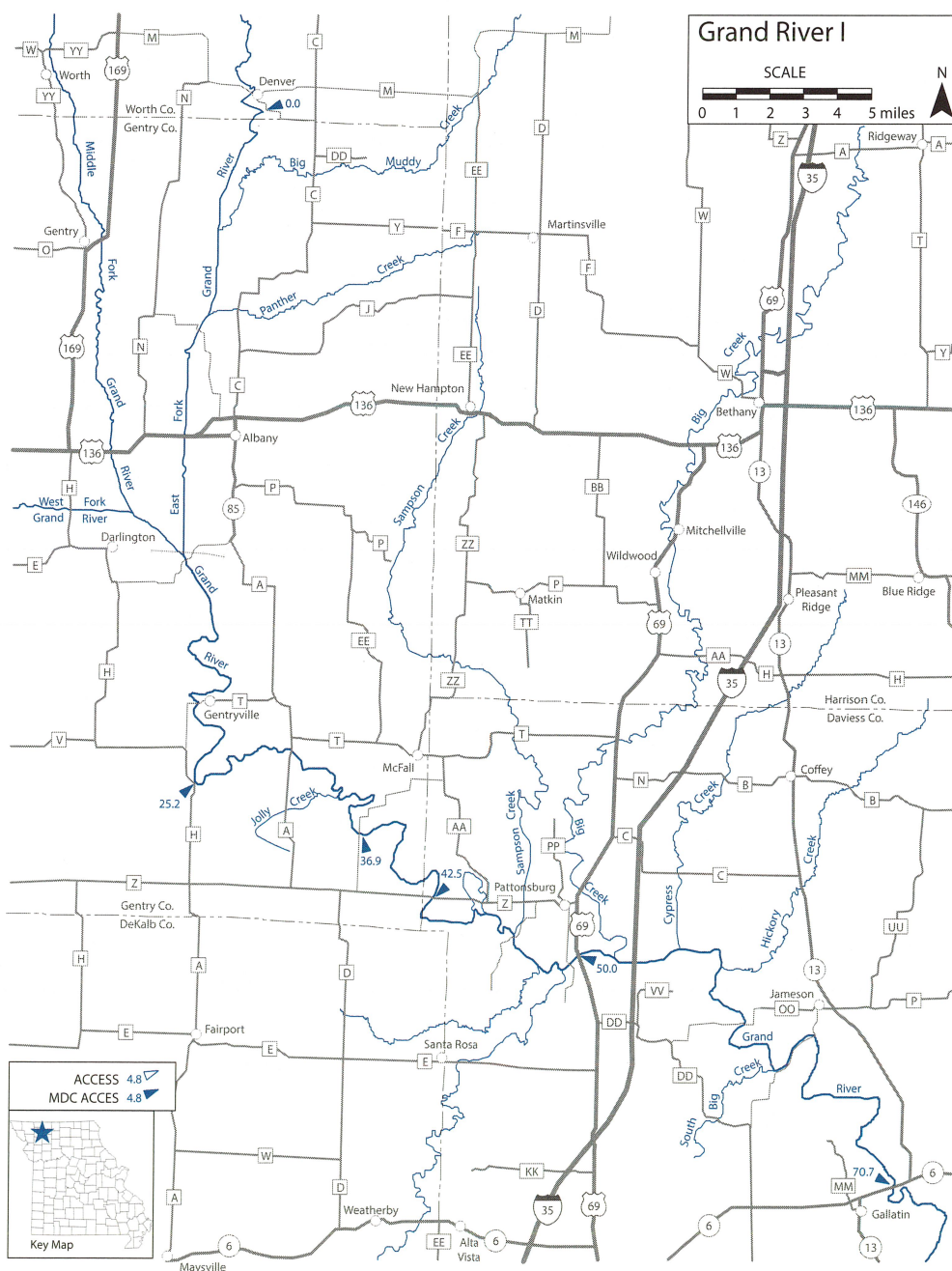
Difficulty: I and II.

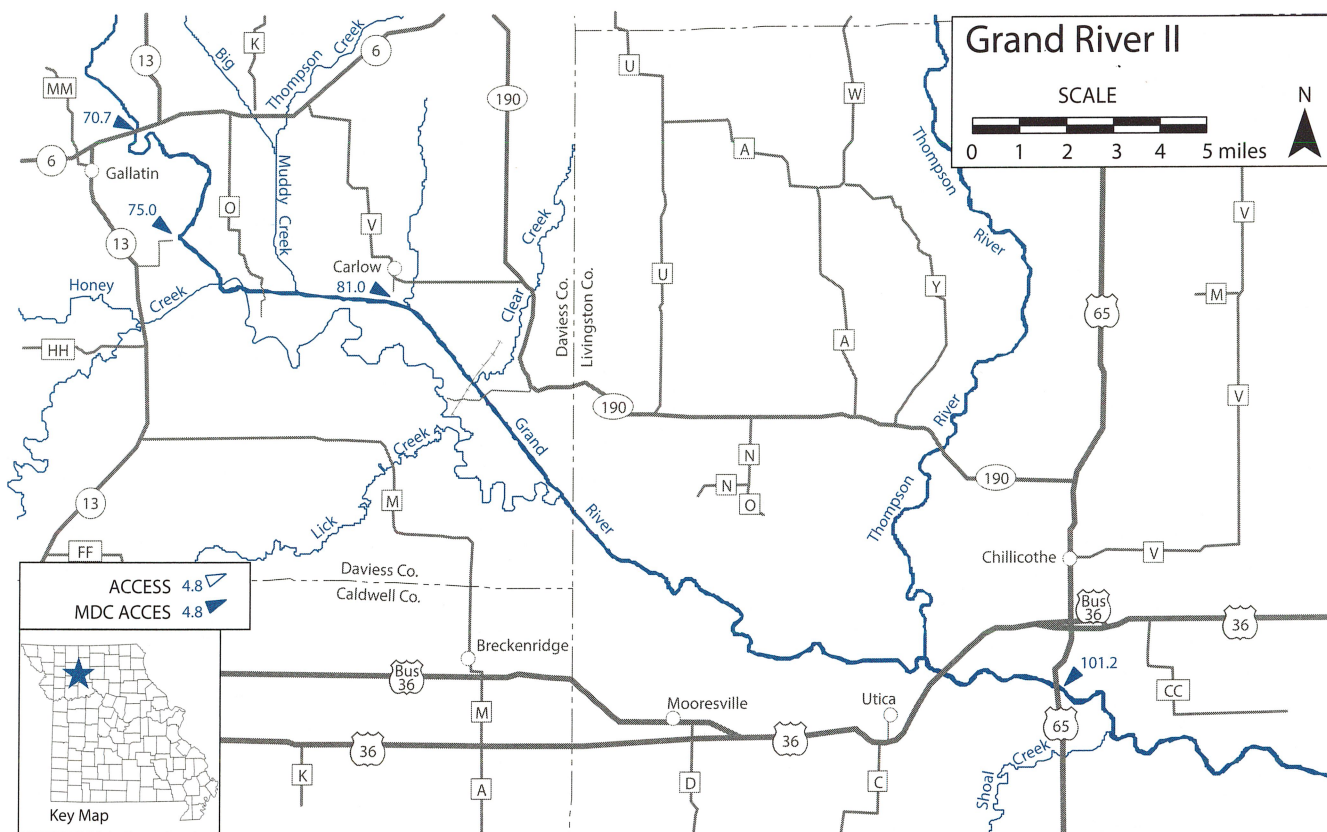
Gradients: general — 3.

Counties: Worth, Gentry, Daviess, Livingston, Carroll, Chariton.

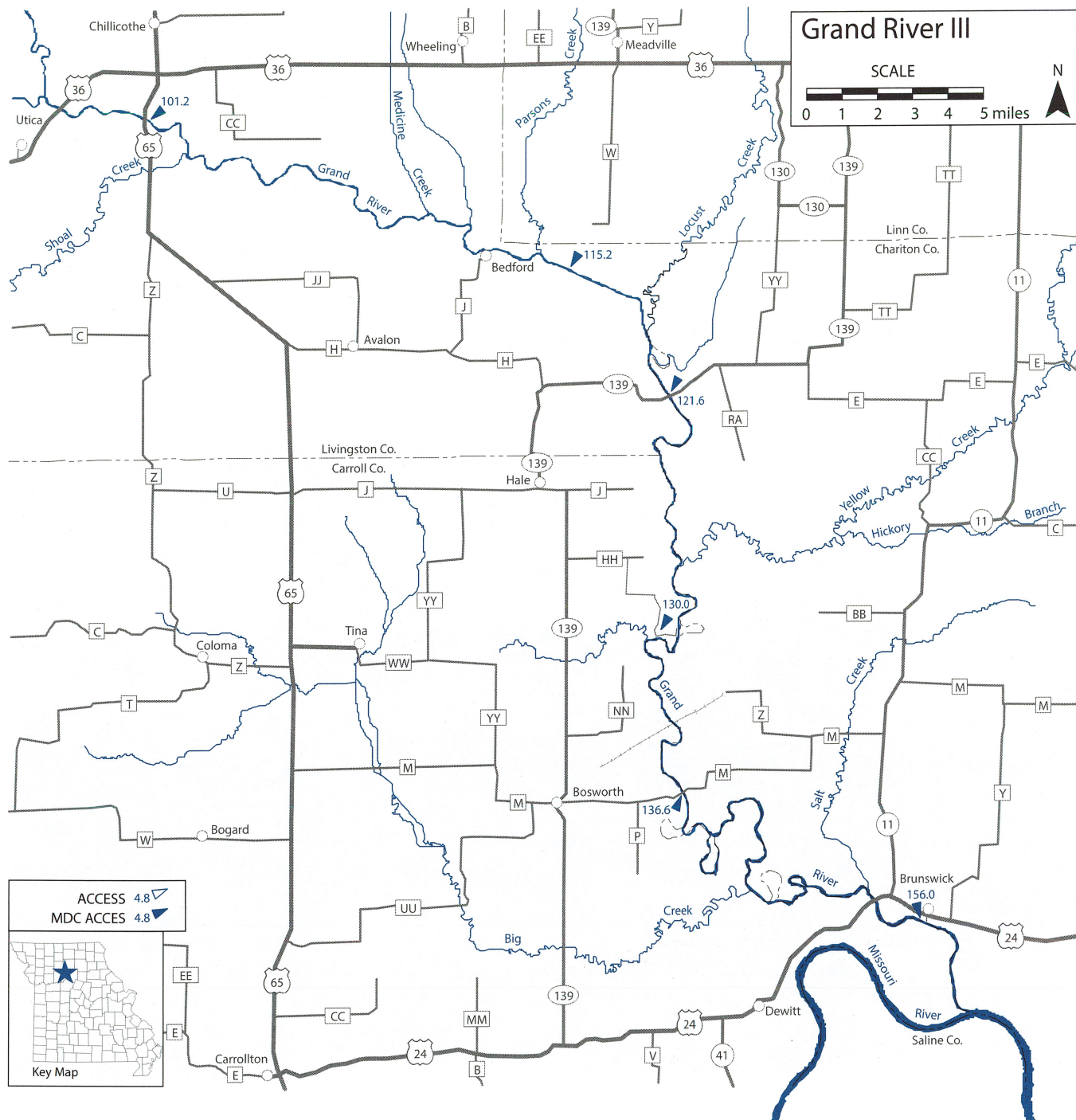
- 0.0 [Sowards Ford Access](#) on the Grand's East Fork. South of Denver off Route M. Must carry boat to gravel bar. ▲
- 2.0 Channelization next 16 miles.
- 5.5 Bridge on Gentry County Road (290th Street) north of Hwy. 136 at Albany.
- 11.5 Hwy. 136 Bridge.
- 16.0 Confluence of East Fork and Grand. Railroad trestle. Middle Fork joins West Fork 2 miles above this point.
- 16.1 Bridge on Gentry County Road (360th/Issac Miller Trail) off Hwy. 85/A.
- 23.0 Bridge on Gentry County Road (405th Street) off end of Route T at Gentryville.
- 25.2 [Andy Denton Access](#) on Route H. Fair access for canoes/kayaks. ▲
- 30.5 Route A Bridge.
- 34.0 Jolly Creek on right and [Elam Bend Conservation Area](#).
- 36.9 Bridge at Gentry County Road (Old Havana Trail), north of Route Z. [Elam Bend CA](#) ramp here. ▲
- 42.5 [Savage Access](#) on Route Z. Fair access for canoes/kayaks.
- 47.0 Sampson Creek left and bridge on Daviess County Road (Haven Road) off Route Z.

- 49.6 Bridge on unimproved Daviess County Road (137th Street) off Route Z south of Old Pattonsburg.
- 50.0 [Green Access](#) at Hwy. 69 Bridge. Fair canoe/kayak access due to 6-foot drop to river.
- 51.5 Big Creek on left.
- 51.8 I-35 Bridge. No access.
- 53.5 Cypress Creek on left.
- 58.0 Bridge on Daviess County Road (July Avenue) off end of Route OO.
- 60.9 South Big Creek on right.
- 62.6 Bridge on Daviess County Road (Kodiak Road) south of Jameson.
- 70.7 [Wabash Crossing Access](#) at Hwy. 6 Bridge. ▲





- 70.7 **Wabash Crossing Access** at Hwy. 6 Bridge.
- 75.0 **Holmes Bend Access**, south of Gallatin off Hwy. 13. Must carry boat to river. Camping area not near river.
- 77.5 Bridge on unimproved Daviess County Road (Sabre Road) off end of Route O.
- 78.2 Big Muddy Creek on left.
- 81.0 **Newman Memorial Access**, south of Carlow off Route V on 300th Street. Fair access for canoes/kayaks.
- 83.5 Railroad trestle. No access.
- 83.7 Bridge on Daviess County Road (Topper Road) west of Lock Springs.
- 97.5 Confluence of Grand and Thompson rivers.
- 98.0 Hwy. 36 Bridge. No access.
- 101.2 **Coval Gann – Chillicothe Access** on Hwy. 65.

- 111.3 Medicine Creek on left.
- 113.7 Bedford on right.
- 115.2 Fountain Grove Conservation Area on left. Canoe/kayak access at parking lot.

- 121.6 Hwy 139 Bridge. Sumner Access.
- 130.0 Little Compton Lake Conservation Area on right. No ramp. Must carry boat to river.

- 134.1 Railroad trestle.
- 136.6 Bosworth Access at Route M.
- 151.2 Salt Creek on left.
- 151.6 Hwy. 24 Bridge. No access.
- 156.0 Brunswick Access at Hwy. 24 and Polk Street in Brunswick.
- 156.2 Railroad trestle.
- 159.0 Missouri River.
