

Maries River

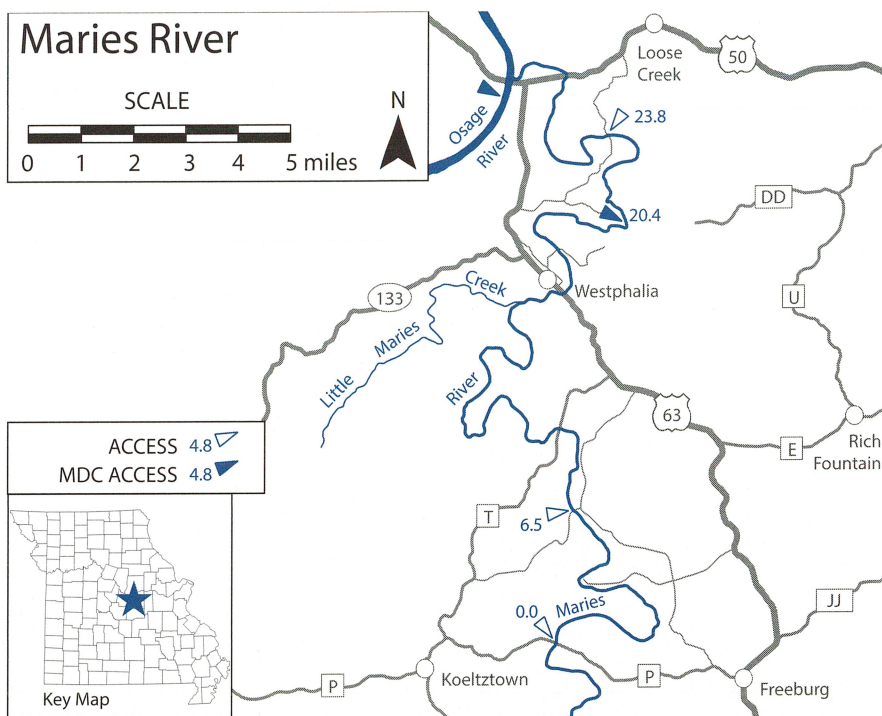
Fast in its upper part but becoming rather sluggish at its lower end, the Maries River may not be floatable in times of low water, yet is still a local fishing favorite.

Difficulty: I and II.

Gradients: upper half — 5.6; lower half — 2.2 (very little gradient below Westphalia).

County: Osage.

- 0.0 Route P Bridge. High water access only. During normal water levels put in below Hwy. 63.
- 6.5 Ford on County Road 521 off Hwy. 63.
- 8.5 Route T Bridge. Private property off state right-of-way.
- 10.1 Ford on private road.
- 15.9 Little Maries Creek on left.
- 16.9 Hwy. 63 Bridge. No access. Heavy traffic.
- 17.9 County Road 611 Bridge.
- 20.4 [Dr. Bernard Bruns Access](#) on left, north of Westphalia, off Hwy. 63. Gravel ramp. ▲
- 23.8 Bridge on County Road 608. Private property off county right-of-way.



- 27.2 Hwy. 50 Bridge. No access. Heavy traffic.
- 28.5 Osage River. Private campground. [Mari-Osa Access](#), across the Osage River, upstream of the Hwy. 50 Bridge on the southwest side. ▲
